

LARAMIE COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

The Clerk of Laramie County, in accordance with the Secretary of State, and as directed by Federal and State mandates, proclaims that November 3, 2020 is the date of the General Election to fill various and prescribed United States, State of Wyoming, District, Laramie County and City of Cheyenne public offices.

All residents of Laramie County who meet the qualifications to register and vote, who are 18 years of age or older on or before November 3, 2020, and if not registered, are encouraged to register on or before October 19, 2020, and participate in this election. Acceptable identification is required to register. Residents may register at the polls on Election Day. Absentee voting begins September 18, 2020, and ends November 2, 2020.

Vote Centers will open at 7:00 a.m. on November 3, 2020, and will remain open until 7:00 p.m. on that date. The Vote Centers shall be as follows:

In addition to offices previously published in the Laramie County Primary Election Proclamation, the following ballot propositions will be submitted to the voters of Laramie County:

Constitutional Amendment A: This amendment will remove the constitutionally specified limit on the amount of debt a municipality can create for sewer projects and would allow the legislature to prescribe by law the debt limit for municipal sewer projects.

Conservation District Tax: “Shall the Laramie County Commissioners continue to impose a conservation district tax, not to exceed one-half (1/2) mill, on all property within Laramie County for the purpose of providing soil and water conservation programs directed by the Laramie County Conservation District? If this proposition is approved, the same proposition shall be submitted at the second following general election or by mail ballot pursuant to W.S. 22-29-114 and 22-29-115, and thereafter at succeeding general elections or by mail ballot pursuant to W.S. 22-29-114 and 22-29-115, every four (4) years until the proposition is defeated.”
