

PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE OF ELECTION
LARAMIE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICTS #2 & #8
CONSOLIDATION ELECTION
LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election is to be held in Laramie County, Wyoming, on Tuesday, August 17, 2021, for qualified electors of Fire District #2 and Fire District #8.

Any qualified registered elector in the Districts shall be entitled to vote on this question in person or by absentee ballot. Residents of Laramie County Fire Districts #2 and #8 who are 18 years of age or older on or before August 17, 2021 and if not registered, are encouraged to register to vote on or before August 3, 2021 and participate in this election.

Acceptable identification is required to register and must be presented in order to vote. Residents may register at the polls on Election Day. Absentee voting begins July 19, 2021 and ends August 16, 2021. Registered voters may request an absentee ballot by calling the County Clerk's Election Office at (307) 633-4242 or by email to election@laramiecountyclerk.com. Requesters must provide their name, date of birth and Wyoming residence address. Absentee ballots must be returned to the Clerk's office by 5:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Polling places will open at 7 a.m. on August 17, 2021, and will remain open until 7 p.m. on that date. The polling places will be located at:

The question on the ballot shall read:

Shall Laramie County Fire District #2 and Laramie County Fire District #8 be consolidated or merged into a successor special district to be called the "Laramie County Fire Authority," with the successor district being a fire protection district under W.S. 35-9-201 et. seq.?

The assessed mill levy will remain the same for Laramie County Fire Authority special district, which levy is equal to the existing mill levy for Laramie County Fire District #2 and also for Laramie County Fire District #8; without a tax increase above the tax already in place as required by W.S. 39-13-104(m).

Shall Fire District #2 and Fire District #8 be consolidated or merged?
