3. Bring your Voter ID and vote on Election Day at **any** Vote Center, Tuesday, Nov. 2, 7:00 a.m.—7:00 p.m.

To register you must be:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Laramie County
- At least 18 years of age on Election Day
- Not convicted of a felony, unless civil/voting rights have been restored
- Not currently adjudicated mentally incompetent



Register at the office of the Laramie County Clerk, your Town Clerk, or at the polls during Early Voting or on Election Day.
