Important information about upcoming Laramie County Fire Authority Bond Election

- **Last day to request an absentee ballot from Laramie County Clerk: Mon., Nov. 6**
- **Deadline to return absentee ballot to County Clerk: 5 p.m., Tues., Nov. 7**
- **Election Day: Tues., Nov. 7, at LCFA Fire Station #71, polls open 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.**

Voters living within the area served by the Laramie County Fire Authority will cast their ballots on Tues., Nov. 7, on the question of authorizing the district to issue \$5.9 million in bonds to support the purchase of fire trucks and other firefighting equipment and for needed improvements to fire stations. The bonds would mature within 5.5 years and would be payable from ad valorem property taxes to pay the annual principal and interest.

There is one polling location on Election Day, open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.: LCFA Fire Station #71, 5800 N. College Drive. Voters are reminded to bring an acceptable government-issued identification, such as a driver's license, Wyoming student or military ID in order to vote.

To be eligible to register and vote in this election, a person must meet the following qualifications: U.S. citizen, resident of Laramie County and residing within the LCFA district, age 18 by Election Day, not adjudicated mentally incompetent and if convicted of a felony, voting rights must have been restored.

Those who are not currently registered may do so at the polling place by presenting their driver's license, Wyoming student or military ID, and signing an application.

Those who prefer to vote at home or in advance may receive an absentee ballot at the County Clerk's election office, Laramie County Governmental Complex, 309 W 20th St., Ste 1500. The last day to request an absentee ballot is Mon., Nov. 6, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Bring your driver's license or other government-issued ID to receive a ballot. The deadline for returning your ballot to the Clerk's office is Tues., Nov. 7, not later than 5 p.m.
